Greetings!


The Central Board of Secondary Education has declared that it will discontinue its international curriculum vide notification ACAD-06/2017. According to the circular, the decision has been taken due to issues related to operational difficulties, including availability of quality reading material of global standards. In the light of this, a mandate has been issued to all the 50 schools in India and 26 schools overseas, directing them to discontinue CBSE-i curriculum from the forthcoming session.

Consequently, affected students of such schools on their promotion to next class (after the end of existing term) would be shifted to CBSE, main curriculum.

Acknowledging the difference between both the curricula, we have resolved that after careful comparison of scope and sequence of the same, the class relevant concepts and gaps, if any, will be taught in the next class during appropriate periods so that the students don't face any problems w.r.t the main curriculum. We assure you that the transition of these students to the next class will be smooth and hurdle-free. We will ensure that the best practices continue to impact our regular teaching-learning.
