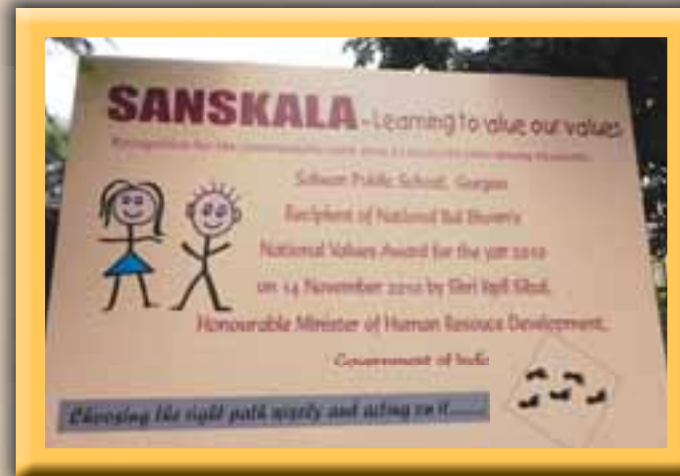

Warm Up Act (Opening Ceremony) of the Common Wealth Games 2010

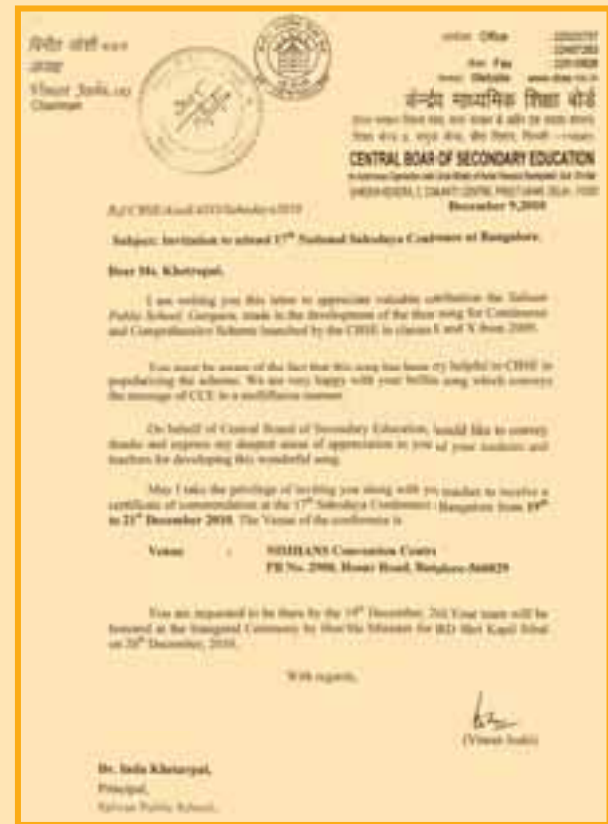


Students perform to the tune- "Aya do hazar dus"

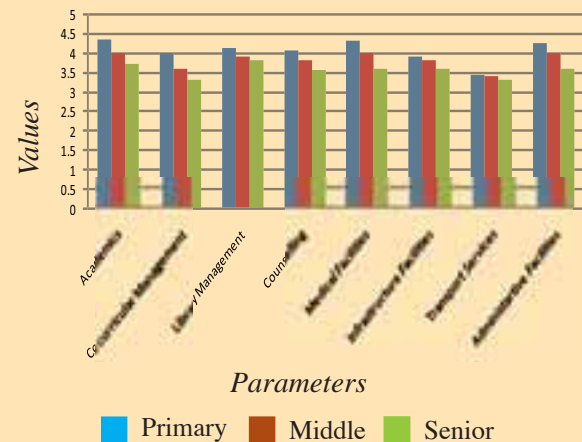

Self Introspection

A survey was conducted by C-Fore, a research agency to rank schools on the basis of different parameters that is- (i) Academic rigour (ii) Extracurricular (iii) Sports (iv) Competence of teachers (v) attention to students (vi) Value for money (vii) Innovative teaching, (viii) Parental participation (ix) Infrastructure and facilities (x) Safety and hygiene (xi) Life skills education and (xii) Social accountability. Among the schools in Gurgaon our school was ranked Fifth by Hindustan Times with 652 out of 900 points.

In the annual Education World C Fore Survey of India's most respected schools, out of 400 schools under the Day, Boarding and International schools category, 250 schools were short listed for the league table. Our school has been ranked 80th at National Level and 42nd at Regional (North Zone Level) under the day school category in the survey.

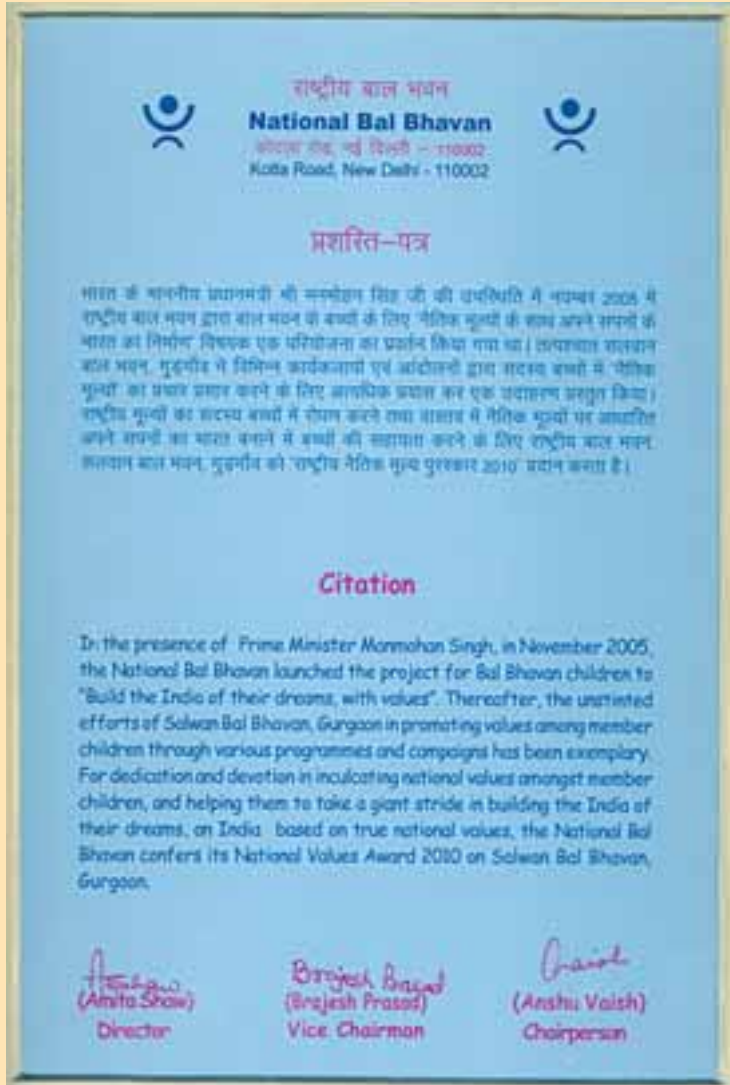
