





What will I learn?	➤ The Southern Plateaus		
To Read & Understand:	<ul> <li>➤ To the south of the Northern Plains of India lies a vast region that is triangular in shape. It is broad towards the north and becomes narrow as we move south. This rocky region is known as the Southern Plateaus.</li> <li>➤ The Southern Plateaus cover a large part of India, measuring about 1,600 km in length from north to south and 1,400 km from east to west.</li> <li>➤ The Southern Plateaus are surrounded by hill ranges on all sides. They are bound by the Western Ghats in the west, the Eastern Ghats in the east, the Aravalli Hills in the northwest and the Rajmahal Hills in the northeast.</li> <li>➤ The River Narmada divides the region of the Southern Plateaus into two parts:         <ul> <li>(a) The Central Highlands in the north, and</li> <li>(b) The Deccan Plateau in the south.</li> </ul> </li> <li>RIVERS OF THE SOUTHERN PLATEAUS</li> <li>➤ The land of the Southern Plateaus is rocky and uneven.         <ul> <li>Because of this, the rivers of this region flow very fast, and often form waterfalls. However, these rivers are not as big as the rivers of the Northern Plains, and are dependent on rain.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>		

	<ul> <li>In the summers, many of these rivers dry up, or have very little water. This is why they are called seasonal rivers. Since the rivers do not have water all year round, dams have been built on the rivers to store water. One such dam, the Nagarjunasagar Dam, is built on the River Krishna.</li> <li>The northern rivers, on the other hand, are snow-fed and have water all year round, being perennial rivers.</li> <li>A number of rivers of the Central Highlands such as Chambal, Son and Betwa join the rivers Ganga and Yamuna from the south. They flow into the Bay of Bengal.</li> <li>Deccan Plateau slopes from west to east. Most rivers such as the Mahanadi, Godavari, Krishna and Kaveri rise in the west and fall into the Bay of Bengal. However, Narmada and Tapi rivers begin in the Vindhya Ranges and flow westwards, falling into the Arabian Sea.</li> </ul>





To Read & Understand:	Grasslands are vast areas covered with grasses. They have few bushes and scattered trees. Grasslands usually get a moderate		

amount of rainfall, which is enough to support the growth of grasses but not forests. However, the moderate rainfall ensures that grasslands do not turn into deserts. Grasslands are mostly found in the Temperate zone.



Grasslands are known as Prairies in North America, Pampas in Argentina, Steppes in Eurasia, Downs in Australia, Veld in South Africa and Savannahs in Central Africa.



The Prairies are vast grasslands located in the interior of North America. In French, the word 'prairie' means 'meadow'.

### THE PRAIRIES

### Location

The Prairies are located in the NorthernHemisphere. They extend from Canada to Mexico. They comprise of vast stretches of gently sloping land covered with grass. Long ago, this area was covered with tall and thick grasses. It served as a grazing ground for bison. Today, it is an important agricultural region of the world.

### Climate

The Prairies have extreme climatic conditions. The summers are hot while the winters are cold. They receive 50 to 70 cm of rainfall in the summer season. The amount of rainfall varies from year to year. Many parts of the Prairies get covered with snow during the winter season.

### Vegetation and Wildlife

The soil in this region is very fertile. This is ideal for the growth of tall grasses, which can grow up to a height of 2 m. Alfalfa is the most common grass here and is fed to cattle. The Prairies were initially grazing lands but they have now been transformed into farmlands. Not many trees are seen here, except in areas where river water is available.

The Prairies support a variety of animals such as coyote, fox, badger and prairie dogs. They are also home to bison, also known as the American buffalo. However bison are now a protected species due to large scale hunting.

### **Agriculture**

Agriculture is an important activity in the fertile prairies. Large parts of grasslands are now under cultivation. Most of the farms are quite large, spreading over many acres. Farmers use scientific methods for cultivation and grow large quantities of crops. Most of the work on the farms such as ploughing, sowing, harvesting, threshing, and winnowing is done by machines.

The main crops grown are corn in the eastern part and wheat in the central part. Other crops grown here include rye, barley and oats. Wheat is grown in large quantities in the Prairies. The wheat produced is enough to feed the entire country and the

	rest is exported. The Prairies are, therefore, known as the 'wheat basket of the world'.
