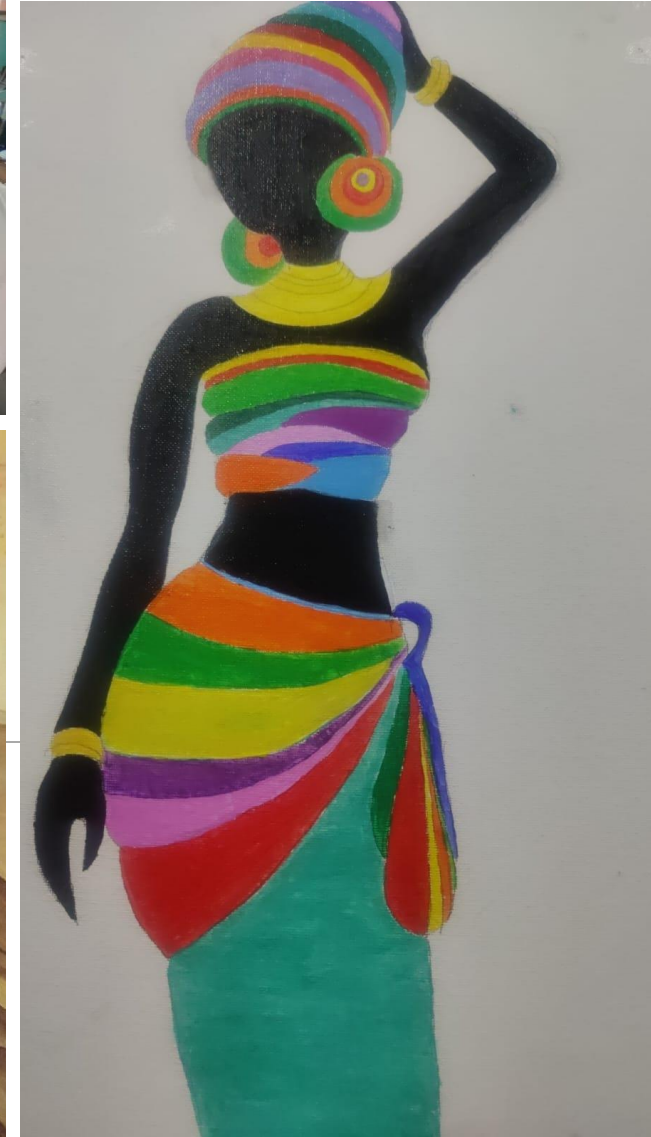
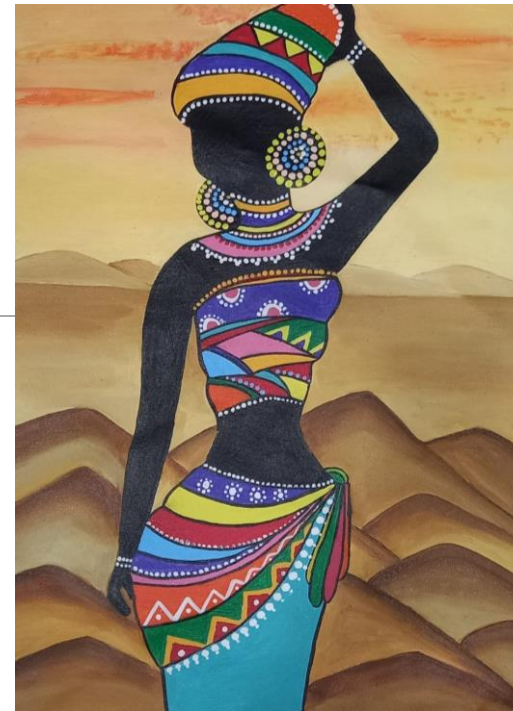
KALAKRITI-INDIAN ART

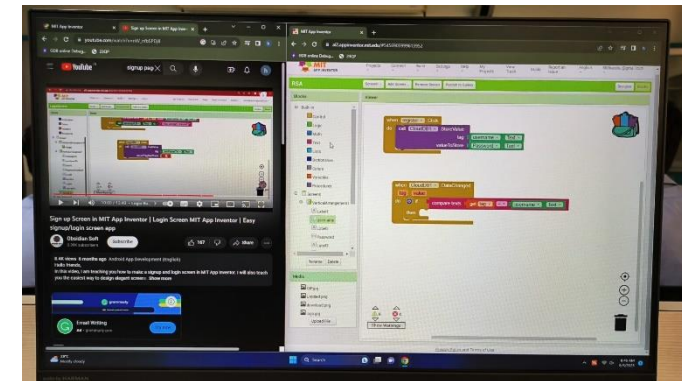
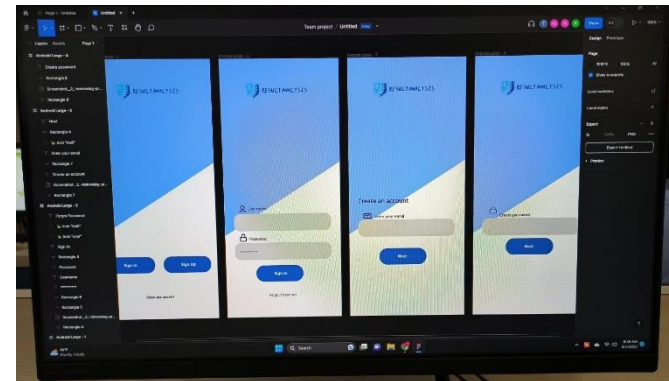
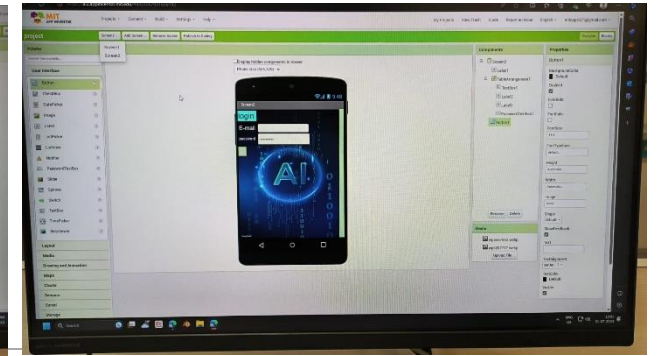
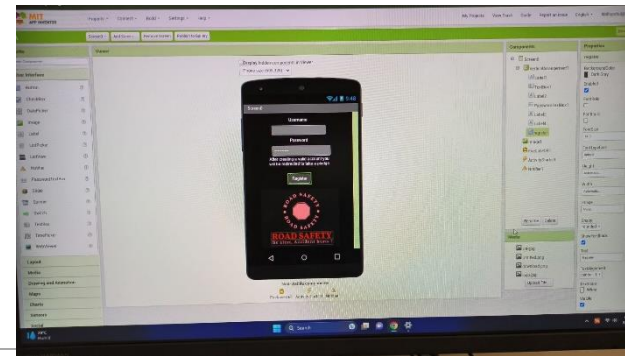
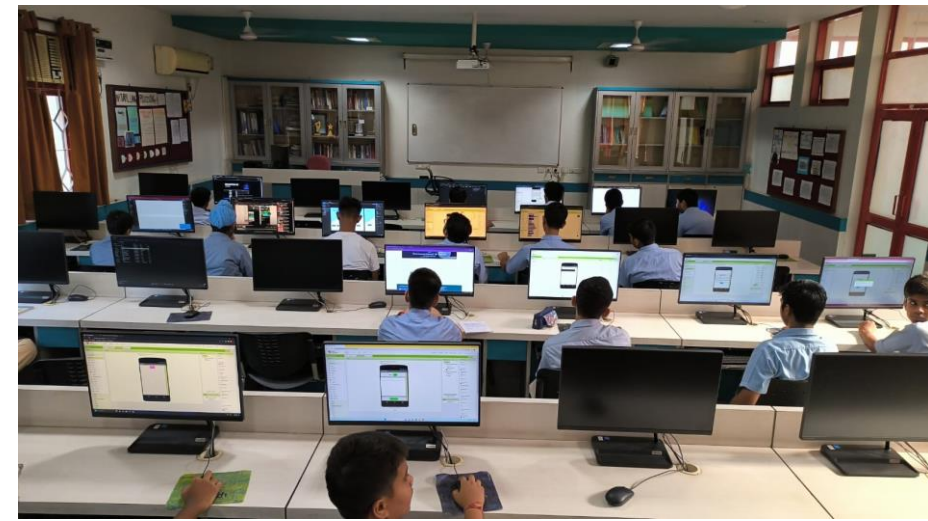
THE INNOVATION HUB-STEAM

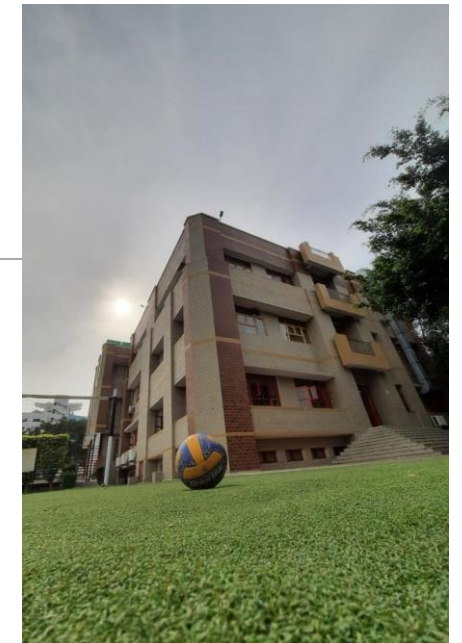
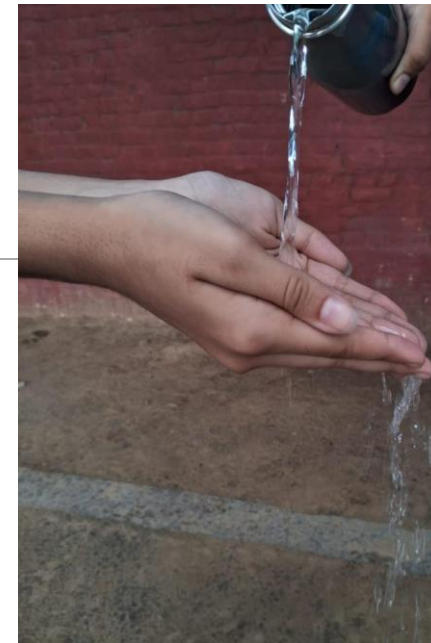
BITS AND BYTES-IT

RANGMANCH

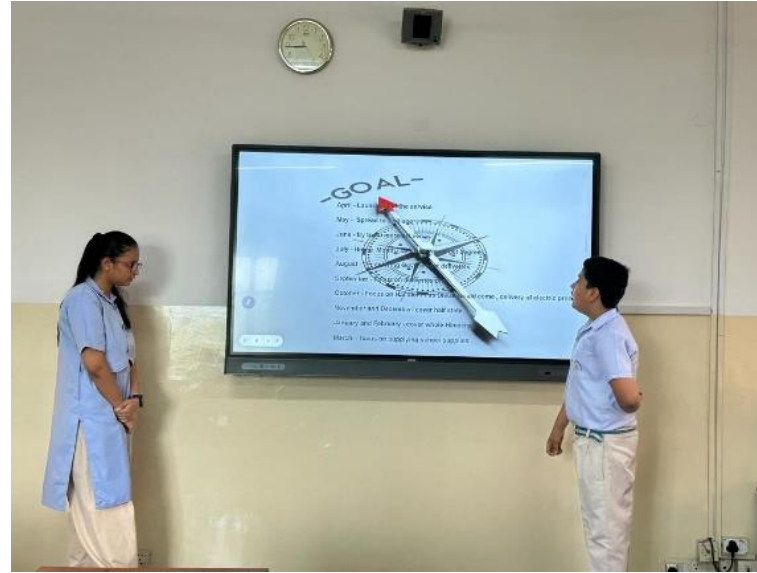
Rangmanch have been focusing on these two major elements of acting, one is body and another is speech and volume.

- **Body In theatre acting:** Body movements play a crucial role in expressing emotions and conveying the character's personality. Gestures, posture, and facial expressions collectively contribute to a convincing performance. Subtle movements can convey nuance, while larger gestures may emphasize key moments. It's essential for actors to be aware of their body language to effectively communicate with the audience and enhance the overall theatrical experience. These all nuances were drilled during the Club sessions.
- **Voice and speech:** Voice and speech are integral aspects of theatre acting. A well-trained voice allows actors to project, articulate, and modulate effectively. Clear enunciation ensures that dialogue is easily understood by the audience. Additionally, variations in pitch, tone, and pace help convey emotion, establish character traits, and create dramatic impact. Vocal warm-ups and exercises are common in theatre training to enhance an actor's vocal range and control, contributing to a powerful and engaging stage presence. The members have developed a knack of appropriate voice through as per the demand of the character.

MENTAL GYM-MATHEMATICS

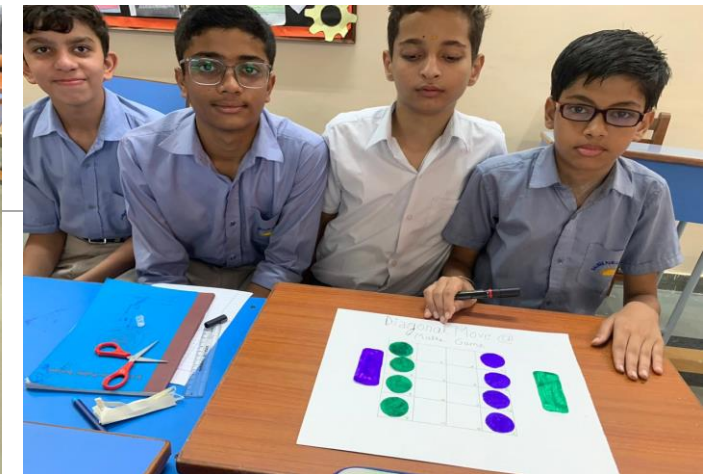
The students were engaged in the following activities to develop their mental agility:
